## Background

The National Institute of Health and Nutrition (NIHN), established in 1920, is the world's oldest national research institute in the field of nutrition.

"Asian Network Symposium on Nutrition" is the main international symposium hosted by the NIHN, which has been held once every two year since 2004. The first symposium entitled "Optimizing Maternal and Child Nutrition for the Prevention of Chronic Diseases" was held in January 2004, followed by the second one entitled "Nutrition Reference and Dietary Recommendation in Asian Countries ~ from nutrition science to policy~" in March 2006. At each symposium, the nutrition researchers and professionals, both in Japan and abroad, were invited for the academic debates and exchange of views on the issues related to the sub-theme.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> symposium will be held on 1<sup>st</sup> March 2008, with focusing on the theme of community nutrition programs and nutrition monitoring. In Japan, the National Nutrition Surveys have been undertaken annually since 1946, which contributed to identify the priority nutrition issues among the population, as well as to promote community-based nutrition programs.

Now, many countries face with "double burden of malnutrition": the persistent of undernutrition along with a rapid rise in obesity and diet-related chronic diseases. With a growing awareness of importance of nutrition monitoring to address the priority issues, the number of countries who introduced a regular nutrition monitoring at the national level has been increasing. At the upcoming symposium, we expect to deepen the debates on present situation and future direction of each country and the Asian region.
