Food environments differ enormously depending on the context. They can be extensive and diverse, with a seemingly endless array of options and price ranges, or they can be sparse, with very few options which will affect the consumer's choice and eating behavior. Creating a healthy food environment enables people to easily adopt sustainable and healthy dietary practices. Effective actions by policy-makers include: 1) coordinating trade, food system and agricultural policies with the protection and promotion of public health; 2) encouraging consumers' demand for healthy foods and meals; and 3) promoting healthy nutrition across the life course. The unhealthy food environment negatively influences especially child dietary patterns, driving increases in childhood overweight and obesity (WPRO. 2020).

The 10th Asian Nutrition Network Symposium aims to provide an opportunity to discuss challenges and future strategies of a sustainable healthy diet in preventing and controlling childhood obesity by sharing experiences and policies in Asia Pacific countries from the viewpoint of a healthy food environment.
