6) Expected number of participants and eligibility

About 30-35 participants (10-15 from Asian countries and 20 from Japan)

Eligibility criteria for application include;

- Working/research experience in the field of community nutrition or/and nutrition sciences
- Communication skills (including discussion) in English
- Highly motivated personal with future leadership in $\underline{\text{community nutrition}}$ or/and $\underline{\text{nutrition sciences}}$

Note: All the participants are supposed to participate in the program for 3 days throughout.

7) Participation fee:

<u>Participation fee is free of charge</u>. For overseas participants, minimum travel expenses (air-fares and accommodation) during the IUNS workshop will be covered by the Local Organizing Committee.
